

## Charity Quilt Pattern 2019

## Disappearing 9 patch

Materials for one block:
4 five inch blocks of same/similar color (color \#1)
4 five inch blocks of a different same/similar color (color \#2)
1 five inch white block
Layout for 9 patch block:
Use accurate 1/4" seam.
Size of block: 14 "
Unfinished


| Color 1 | Color 2 | Color 1 |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Color 2 | White | Color 2 |
| Color 1 | Color 2 | Color 1 |

Slice block in half vertically ( $7^{\prime \prime}$ ), then turn and slice in half horizontally.
Turn top left block and bottom right block 180 degrees. Sew. The 2 center white squares should be as pictured going left to right.

Block will be $13 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
Repeat with other colors or same colors making sure a white block is in the center.
You would need about 15 blocks for baby/toddler; about 24 blocks for twin size.
