

## Six Strip Fence: Finished quilt will be $63^{\prime \prime} \times 81^{\prime \prime}$

Blocks: ( 9 " blocks) 63 blocks set $7 \times 9$
Binding: 8 yards required
Batting: twin or 71" x 89"
Backing: 5 yards required
Color sets: Assorted darks: 2 yards
Assorted mediums: 2 yards
Assorted lights : 2 yards
Cutting:
Cut 126-2" x 9.5" strips from each of the 3 color sets. (Total of 378 strips.)
Sewing:
To make each block, sew 6 strips (2" x 9.5") together lengthwise. Sew 7 blocks per row placing blocks perpendicular to make a rail fence arrangement. You will need 9 rows. Sew rows together to complete the top. Add stay stitching around the entire quilt to secure seams.

Quilting: An overall pattern works well. Bind.
